Regular — \$600.00

- ☆ We grow all of the vegetables for the CSA shares in our fields and unheated greenhouses.
- ☆ We choose open pollinated and heritage vegetables that may be different than the normal “grocery store” varieties.
- ☆ Carrots are red and yellow along with orange and purple. Beets are red, golden and red and white striped. Beans are green, purple, and striped.
- ☆ Approximately 20—22 baskets will be received each growing year, depending on what mother nature gives us.
- ☆ The baskets include a share of everything that is in season and ready to harvest.
- ☆ This means that you will have different baskets each week that will challenge your taste buds and encourage creativity in cooking
